

2026 JACC Apprenticeship Qualification Checklist

Joint Apprenticeship Corporate Committee (JACC) bids will open January 19th and close January 30th. Openings for the **Automotive Technician, Construction & Maintenance Man, Lineman, Machinist, Metal Fabricator, Meterman, Plant Electrician and Substation Electrician** trades are anticipated.

In addition to being capable of performing the functions in both the Apprentice and Journeyworker job descriptions, candidates applying to be considered for selection as a Pre-Apprentice or Apprentice must meet the following minimum qualifications to participate in the 2026 JACC Apprenticeship Selection Process:

No Actions Required	<input type="checkbox"/>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a current SRP employee at least 18 years of age or older, with a High School Diploma or GED. • Have no active discipline for entirety of selection process (1/30/2026 – 5/11/2026). • Possess driving privileges or be able to obtain driving privileges relevant to their desired trade (Class “A” Commercial Driver’s License required for Cable Splicer, C&M Man, Lineman and Substation Electrician trades).
	<input type="checkbox"/>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a valid Physical Agility Test (“Meets Requirement” or is “In Classification”) on file with Talent Acquisition department by close of bids. Test scores must be valid through 1/30/2026. • Test is verified by Talent Acquisition after submission of Apprenticeship Candidate Profile. Candidates will be notified of their status by email. • The apprenticeship office confirms valid tests with Talent Acquisition for qualification.
Actions Required	<input type="checkbox"/>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit an application by the bid close date. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Applications may be submitted through OneWorkforce. ○ Candidates may only apply for one JACC trade. ○ Candidates may designate a backup JACC Trade when completing their Apprenticeship Candidate Profile in the Apprenticeship Candidate Site (See Selection Procedure for details). ○ No applications will be accepted after the bid close date (1/30/2026).
	<input type="checkbox"/>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receive a complete 2026 Apprenticeship Candidate Referral meeting expectations in both Job Performance and Attendance & Reliability from direct supervision by the bid close date. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Candidates must request a candidate referral using the Apprenticeship Candidate Site. ○ Referrals must be requested by the candidate and approved by supervision between 12/15/2025-1/30/2026.

Supporting Documentation Required	<p>Submit an Apprenticeship Candidate Profile using the Apprenticeship Candidate Site prior to the bid close date (1/30/2026). CANDIDATE PROFILES SHOULD INCLUDE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (If applicable for trade) Proof of completion or enrollment in required prerequisite classes (see page 2 for prerequisite requirements). • Any post-high school education experience documentation, as this may be used to award education experience points in the selection process. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Documentation must be submitted on educational transcripts (official or unofficial) or from the appropriate reporting system. High school transcripts will not be considered. ○ Proof of attending an Apprenticeship Information Meeting does not need to be submitted. ○ See Education Experience Points Rubric in Selection Procedure for information on how points are awarded. • Documentation of previous work experience (excluding SRP Work Experience), as this may be used to award work experience points in the selection process. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Work experience documentation must include five items: 1) Company name, 2) Dates of employment with at least month and year, 3) Job title, 4) Job description, 5) Verifiable contact information for employer. ○ See Work Experience Points Rubric in Selection Procedure for information on how points are awarded.

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Educational Prerequisites

No prerequisites are required if either the applicable subcommittee does not require them for their trade or prerequisites are fulfillable through an established pre-apprenticeship program.

- Though proof of enrollment and unofficial transcripts are acceptable to qualify for trades with prerequisite requirements, proof of completion on an official transcript is required within 90 days of indenture.
- Proof of completion or enrollment is required to be submitted prior to bid close to qualify.
- For trades with prerequisites, those selected have 90 days from the program start to provide proof of completion with a grade of "C" or better on an official transcript. Those who do not provide proof of completion of educational prerequisites with a grade of "C" or better on an official transcript within the 90 days from program start are removed from the program.

College-Level Algebra or Equivalent (Pre-Apprentice)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Completion or enrollment in College Algebra (MAT 114 or higher) required prior to bid close to qualify for selection as pre-apprentice. 2. Completion or enrollment in College Algebra (MAT 150 or higher) required prior to bid close to qualify for selection as apprentice.
College-Level Intermediate Algebra Equivalent (Apprentice)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. <i>Those selected who have not completed College Algebra (MAT 150 or higher) are selected as pre-apprentices (regardless of rank) and may complete requirement during Pre-Apprenticeship. Proof of College Algebra (MAT 150 or higher) completion is required within 90 days of indenture.</i>
